

Tawes Appoints Luetkemeyer

John N. Luetkemeyer, president of the Equitable Trust Company, has been appointed to the three-man Banking Board of Maryland for a six-year term by Governor Tawes, it was announced yesterday.

Mr. Luetkemeyer, born in Cleveland, Ohio, came to Equitable shortly after graduating from Harvard University and attending Harvard Law School. In 1948 he became a director of the bank. He was elected executive vice president in January, 1960, and president in 1961.

He is a director and treasurer of the American Cancer Society, as well as a director of the Savings Bank of Baltimore, the Maryland Life Insurance Company, and Johnson Motor Lines, Inc.

Mr. Luetkemeyer also serves as vice president of the board of trustees of Goucher College, a trustee of Calvert School, Church Home and Hospital, and the Evergreen House Foundation.
