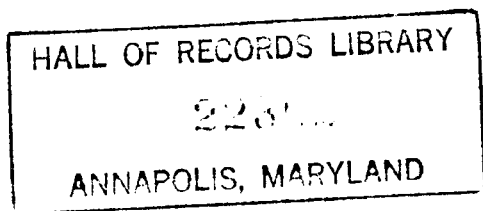

JUMP atty Denton, b nr Greensborough, Car Co, 2nd dist, Dec 7 1833; descends from Rev ancestors, English and Scotch lineage 3 bros emigrated c. 1700; 1 settled at Bohemia Manor, Md, another in the south, and 3rd in Del. John Jump, subject's father, b Del 1800; at 30 came to Md, settling nr Denton, purch farm; tax collector; co sheriff; d 1847. His bro, Rbt B., fruit farmer Del. Mother of subj, Elizabeth Clements, b Del; traced lineage to Scotland. Subject's only bro, Thos Hy, d in boyhood. 5 sis living: Mollie E., res Wilm, Del; Lydia A., wid of Dr. John W. Cannaway, res

Wilm; Sarah E., wid of Wm. C. Smith, farmer res nr Easton; Louisa, res Camden, Del; and Belle C., w/o Jos E. Wilson, mcht Barclay, QA Co.

Subj educated dist schools and acad; at 13 assist office of clerk circuit court; read law with J. E. Rochester; admitted to bar 1857; clerk circuit court; 1864 elected comptroller of Md. Ensuing yrs devoted to practice of law. 1891 elected state's atty Car Co; 1896 app rgtr of wills vacated by death of Jas B. Steele; elected to office 1897. 1855 he m Laura Cochran, d/o Chas and Elizabeth (Benson) Cochran, of Del; her father mcht of Cambridge, Md. Child. of Mr. and Mrs. Jump: Elizabeth E., wid of Marion Pippin; Alexander, d at 2 yrs; Ella, decd, w/o J. N. Todd, atty; Rbt J., clerk N.Y. City; and Chas C., city editor Meriden (Conn.) Record.
