

**DEATH OF SENATOR GAITHER.**—We regret to learn that General William Lingan Gaither, of Montgomery county, Md., died at Berkeley Springs, on Monday last. The deceased had been long in public life, and was well known throughout the State as a gentleman of fine talents, a high sense of honor, and sterling integrity. He had frequently represented Montgomery county in both branches of the State Legislature, and at the time of his death was a member of the Senate, of which body he was for many years the presiding officer. He was also, until recently, a director on the part of the State in the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company, and it was while in this city, a year or so ago, in the discharge of his duty, that he was stricken down by a violent attack of typhoid fever, from the effects of which he never entirely recovered.
