

*Death of Gen. Wm. Lingan Gaither.*—A private telegraphic dispatch was received in this city last evening, from Berkley Springs, announcing the death, at that place, on Monday morning last, of Gen. William Lingan Gaither, late of Montgomery county, Maryland. Gen. Gaither was well known in this State as a prominent politician. He represented his county for several years in the House of Delegates, and at present was a member of the State Senate. The deceased was distinguished for his high-toned gentlemanly qualities and eminent talents.

Somewhat over a year ago Gen. Gaither was attacked severely, whilst sojourning at Barnum's Hotel, in this city, with typhoid fever, and never fully recovered from its effects. He had gone to the Berkley Springs in the hope of recuperating, but his constitution was too much impaired.
