Proceedings of the House

December 29, 1802: Young accuses John Hardcastle and Robert Orrell of "fabrication and malevolence" in alleging that Young had embezzled money from the estate of Valentine Green.

January 7, 1802: House resolved "that no imputation attaches against the said Robert Orrell and John Hardcastle...." The House also ruled that the charges of embezzlement brought against Young were unfounded.

January 10, 1803: Vote of censure passed on Young "in consequence of the language used by him in his said memorial...."

January 5, 1804: The speaker read before the House a letter from John Young concerning the vote of censure passed on Young during the previous session.

January 7, 1804: A committee reported that Young had not deserved the vote of censure since "no blame or censure can attach to Mr. Young from his conduct." A resolution to this effect was passed by the House on the same day.
