last will and Testament } In the name of God Amen. - I Elizabeth Thomas of Saint Mary's County being sick and weak of body but of sound and perfect mind memory and understanding do make and constitute this my last will and testament in manner and form following, that is to say, First I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God and my body to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of an Executor hereinafter named. - Item, I give and devise to my Grandson James Thomas and Eliza his wife and their heirs forever all the Lands that I have any right or title to together with the crops growing thereon at the time of my decease. - Item, I give and bequeath to my Son William Thomas all my Bank Stock and all the debts due me on bond or note together with the dividends and interest which may not have been paid on the same at the time of my decease; also one negro man known by the name of Little Gerard and a negro man called Brutus. - Item, I give and bequeath to my two Granddaughters Eliza Thomas and Maria Thomas Courts one negro man called Gerard one negro woman called Abby and a woman called Esther. - Item, I give to my Granddaughter Eliza Thomas one negro girl called Barnot. - Item, I give to my Granddaughter Maria Thomas Courts one negro boy called Nace a boy called Gerard and a girl called Clarissa. - Item, I give to my Grandson James Thomas one negro boy called Barry likewise all the debts that may be due me for the hire of negroes. - Item, I give to my Grandson George Thomas one negro boy called Moses. - Item, I give to my Grandson William Thomas a negro boy called George. - Item, I give to my Grandson Richard Thomas a boy called Abraham. - Item, I give to my Granddaughter Matilda Thomas a negro boy called Barry the son of Alice. - Item, I give to my Granddaughter Catharine Thomas a negro girl called Alice. - Item, I give to my Grandson William Presley Thomas a negro boy called Lewis and a girl called Eleanor. - Item, I give to my Granddaughter Elizabeth Charlotte Thomas one negro boy called Homelous and a girl called Charity. - Item, my will and desire is that the remainder and residue of my estate be equally divided between my Son William Thomas and my Granddaughter Maria Thomas Courts and I do hereby constitute and appoint my Son William Thomas whole and sole Executor of this my last will and testament revoking and annulling all other wills by me heretofore made ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twentieth day of May one thousand eight hundred and eight. -
