In 1994, I was appointed as judge on the Court of Appeals of Maryland, Maryland's highest court. And in 1973, I was the first woman assistant state's attorney for Montgomery County.

In addition to continuous mentoring of practicing lawyers, I mentor young women in junior high school and high school. As an example, I recently called another judge's chambers, and when I said my name, the law clerk, a young new lawyer, told me: "You are the reason that I am a lawyer. You were on a panel at my school when I was in the eighth grade, and that is when I decided to go to law school"
