ANNAPOLIS — Maryland's Speaker of the House is going to Harvard University.

House Speaker Casper R. Taylor Jr. recently was asked to speak during a joint meeting hosted by the National Speakers Conference and the John F. Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University on Feb. 16.

The conference is designed to educate new speakers of the House on the challenges and opportunities they will face as new leaders of their respective state governments.

Taylor is one of only three veteran speakers of the House asked to address the conference.

The National Speakers Conference

is a component of the State Legislative Leaders Foundation.

The NSC serves all speakers of the House in the nation, and was established in 1990 to recognize the special role speakers play in the legislative process.

Taylor was elected to the NSC Board of Directors last year.
