

*First Colored Public School Teacher.*—

Roberta Sheridan, colored, has been appointed a teacher at the Waverly colored public school. This is the first appointment of a colored teacher in Baltimore, and is in pursuance of an ordinance passed before annexation that colored teachers shall be appointed hereafter to all colored schools that come into possession of the city. She was born in Baltimore, and is a graduate of the colored high and grammar school, and colored normal school. The growth of the Belt schools has been large since annexation, and another colored teacher will be appointed to the Waverly school next week. The Belt school committee, John T. Foley, chairman, yesterday selected a new school on Boundary avenue, north of North avenue, for an English-German school. The house, not yet finished, was taken in time to have it remodeled for school purposes.
