

THE REPUBLICAN CONVENTION OF MARYLAND at Hagerstown yesterday elected as delegates at large to Chicago Hon. Hart B. Holton, of Baltimore county; Lyeurgus N. Phillips, of Frederick; James Wallace, of Dorchester, and Thomas S. Hodson, of Somerset. They also nominated as electors at large Thomas A. Gorsuch, of Frederick, and Dr. J. J. Weaver, of Carroll county. The platform declares for protection; demands that officeholders shall not control in politics; the suspension of silver dollar coinage and the retirement of the trade dollar. While the convention commends the present administration and declares that Mr. Blaine is the choice of the republicans of Maryland for the next President, the party in this State was pledged only "to the nominees of the republican convention" at Chicago.
