The jury returned an inquisition that the alleged lunatic was insane and a pauper, and the Court passed an order committing the lunatic to the Maryland Hospital for the Insane.

The next case called was No. 2 criminal appearances State vs. John T. Harboe, indicted for an assault on Anna K. Cecil. Trial by jury. Pending this case the Court adjourned for the day. E. B. Abell, Esqr., today moved the admission to this bar of Richard E. King (colored). The Court appointed Messrs. John N. Graves, Jos. F. Morgan and W. L. Dawkins a committee to examine Mr. King and report to the Court. Mr. King made application for admission to this bar at the September Term of the Court, 1886, but failed to pass the examination satisfactorily.
