

MOB KILLS MAN.

Policeman Daugherty's Murderer. Beaten To Death.

Crisfield, Md. (Special)—Crisfield and Somerset County were thrown into a state of intense excitement at a late hour by the murder of Night Chief of Police John H. Daugherty, of this city.

The crime was committed by James Reed, a negro of North Carolina, who had been living in Crisfield for the past eight months.

After a long, stern chase Sunday morning in gasoline launches, Reed, after being fired upon, was captured, brought back to Crisfield and beaten to death by an angry mob of citizens.

Stringing his dead body to a telegraph pole the rioters surged through the colored settlement, took negro men from their cabins, mauled them fiercely and bade them leave town.
