

The undersigned, jury of inquest upon the body of Michael Green, colored, hung by a mob on the night of the 1<sup>st</sup> of September 1878, do certify that we have carefully examined the jail from which he was taken and find that the locks of said jail were broken off in a skilful manner, and that no precaution upon the part of the Sheriff was omitted for the safe custody of said Green and the other prisoners confined therein; we recommend however that the door of said jail be strengthened
