

Judge Sherbow Funeral Today

Funeral services for Joseph Sherbow, a former judge of the Supreme Bench of Baltimore City, will be held today at 10:30 a.m. in the Baltimore Hebrew Congregation Temple on Park Heights avenue. Mr. Sherbow, a well-known attorney who advised governors over the years and who specialized in tax and constitutional law, was 78. He died Sunday at Sinai Hospital after a brief illness.

While on the Supreme Bench Judge Sherbow was frequently out-spoken with a reputation for criticizing certain traditional aspects of the courts. He was a constant crusader for judicial reforms.

After his retirement from the Supreme Bench in 1952 he returned to his law practice and litigated corporate and public-utilities cases. He served as chairman of the Appellate Judicial Nominating Commission which screens candidates for Maryland's Court of Appeals and Court of Special Appeal.

Mr. Sherbow is survived by his wife Sara, and sons Theodore and Arthur Sherbow, and a daughter, Joan Winston, and 12 grandchildren.
