STATEMENT OF VOTES CAST

REPUBLICAN

PRIMARY ELECTION HELD

TUESDAY, APRIL 7, 1931.

We, the undersigned, constituting the Board of Supervisors of Elections of Baltimore City, and the Board of Canvassers for the City of Baltimore, do hereby state that we did duly meet at the usual place of holding, the Superior Court of Baltimore City, on Thursday, April 9, 1931, at twelve o'clock noon, being the Thursday next following the day of the Primary Election held on Tuesday, April 7, 1931, and having each of us duly taken the oath required by law to be taken by us as said Board of Canvassers, did organize by electing Robert B. Ennis, Chairman and Bernard J. Flynn, Secretary of said Board of Canvassers; and we do further certify that we did open all the original statements and returns delivered or transmitted to us of the Republican vote cast at said Primary Election, being all the returns from each of the Election precincts of the FOURTH COUNCILMANIC DISTRICT OF Baltimore City, comprising the 4 and 6 Precincts of the Fourth Ward; the Thirteenth and Fourteenth Wards; the 26 to 50 Precincts, Inclusive, of the Fifteenth Ward; the 1, 2, 3 and 33 Precincts of the Sixteenth Ward, the Seventeenth Ward, for the Republican nomination of THREE MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE CITY from the FOURTH COUNCILMANIC DISTRICT.

And we do further certify and state as a results of said canvass and addition, that for the Republican nomination for THREE MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE CITY from the FOURTH COUNCILMANIC DISTRICT, the following is shown to be the total vote cast for all candidates for said nomination to wit:

And we do accordingly declare that the said DANIEL ELLISON, WALTER S. EMERSON and WARNER T. McGUINN were duly nominated as candidates for THREE MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE CITY from the FOURTH COUNCILMANIC DISTRICT, they having received the highest number of votes.
