DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame and rubble stone house is situated on the corner of Glenville and Old Level Roads. The house faces south and is two stories high.

This dwelling's gable flank roof is covered with tin and has wide eaves and a box cornice. A cornice. A corbeled brick chimney is located at each inside end of the house.

The western half of the house is stone, two bays wide. There are no openings on the west end. This side carries the chimney which serves the large cooking fireplace inside. A datestone below the chimney bears the monogram "WCR -1796." A fagot of wheat or some similar grain is located beneath the date. (see photograph, sketch). Windows on the first elevation are six lights over six with a typical sash arrangement. Windows on the second elevation are also 6/6 but with much narrower panes giving a horizontal effect.

The fireplace on the western wall of the stone unit dominates that wall. A large beam is located above the fireplace opening. It measures 12 feet in length and is one foot square. The initials "B.C." are cut into the beam. An 18 feet beam is embedded on the upper part of the south wall of the stone section.

The east unit of this house is frame with aluminum siding covering the old weatherboard. A chimney rises to the peak inside this section, suggesting possible additions in stages from the stone house eastward. Windows in this section vary in size though they are generally 6/6. An addition on the south was made by enclosing a one story porch.

The interior of the frame unit has been completely remodeled.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This stone house, one of the tenant dwellings of the original Westwood Farm, bears a datestone of 1796 and the monogram WCR. It is thought that this refers to a member of the Coale Family who have long been associated with Westwood Farm. It probably refers to William Coale, owner of the property prior to 1811.

The main house of the original farm (now divided) is owned by Mrs. Frederick A. Vogel. This house was built prior to 1800 by Samuel Chase for his daughter, Elizabeth, and her husband Skipwith Coale. Samuel Chase was active in Maryland prior to and during the American Revolution in the cause of liberty. He represented Maryland at the Continental Congress and was one of the signers of the Declaration of Independence. He was also a Chief Justice of the Supreme Court.

A long oblong. The west half of the house is stone, 2 bays ~~wide~~ with no openings in the west wall which carries a chimney from a large cooking fireplace inside. Windows are 6 lights on 6 downstairs, smaller windows upstairs 3 lights on 6.

The east half of the house is frame with aluminum siding covering old weather board. A chimney rises to the peak inside this section (suggesting possible additions in stages from the stone house eastward). Windows are of varied sizes. An addition was made by enclosing a one-story porch.

Modernization of the interior, ~~has not~~ has not interfered with Mrs. Fiedler's restoration of the large stone fireplace in the west room.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Include Personages, Dates, Events, Etc.)

The datestone sketched below indicates probable ownership by a member of the Coale family, since this has been on the Coales' Westwood (Main) tract since before 1800 until 1928. What relationship had W & R C to the Ship with Coale whose wife Elizabeth was given the grand Westwood (HA 675) by her father Samuel Chase, signer of the Declaration of Independence and Chief Justice of the Supreme Court? Research needed?

This simple house, was later owned by a Davis family whose daughter Suzanne married Dr Roberts, thought to have added the frame section. Its great well, ~~was~~ in use until at least the 1890's, has disappeared without a trace. Mantel's map shows Dr



Roberts owned 2 houses, one HA 147-8, one south of Greenville Road ^{possibly} HA 146-7.

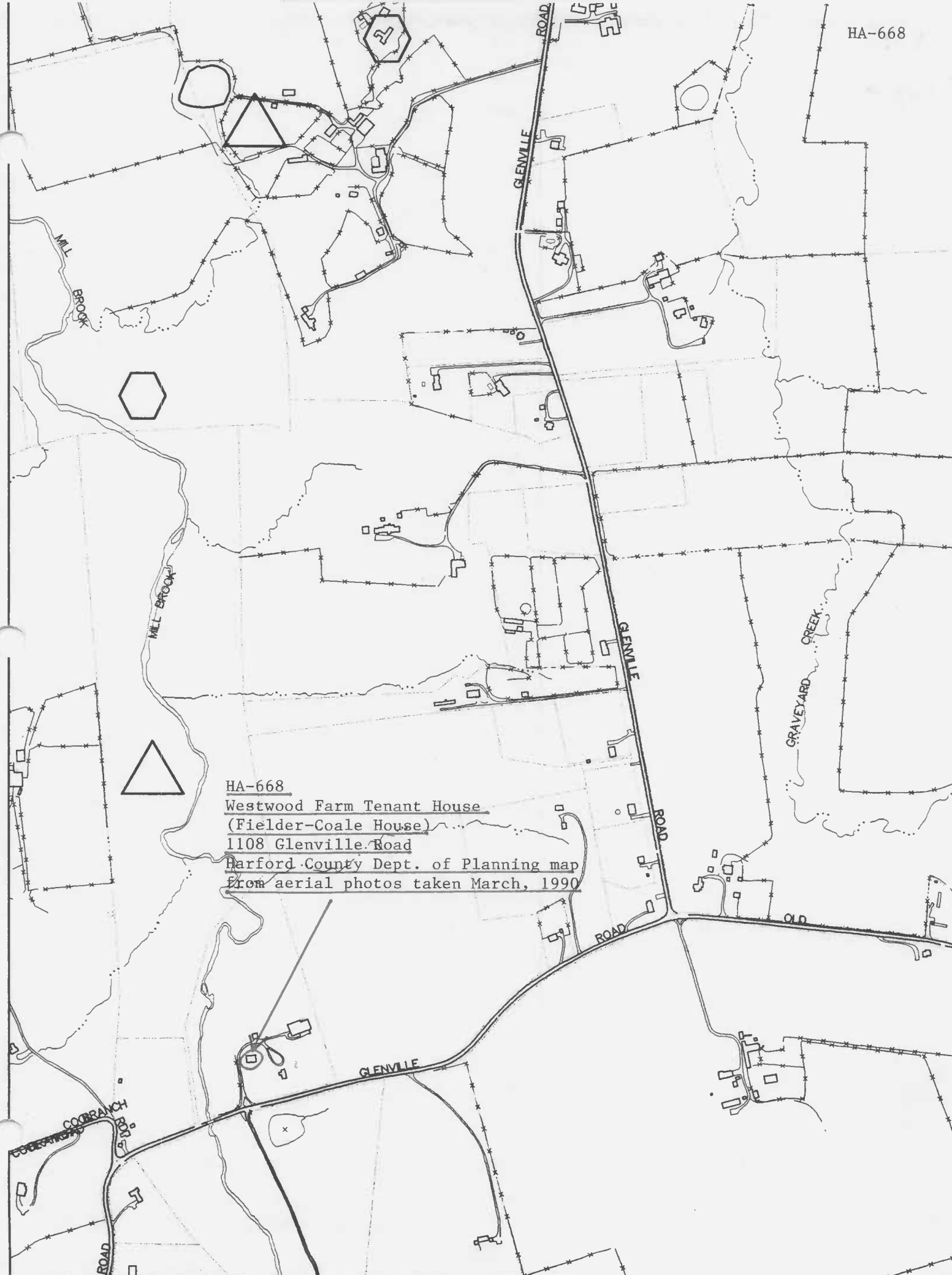
