Proper Benefit and use and for here by Warrant him the said Servant and his Service  
for the times aforesaid to him the said Edmund Jennings his Ex<sup>o</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup> and Assigne from all Sales  
Incumbrances and Other Charges by me made on the said Servant or his aforesaid times of Service
