

Death of Mrs. Anna Bentley.

Mrs. Anna Bentley died last Thursday evening at her home at Green Hill, between Hanover and Minerva, aged 94 years. The remains were brought to this city and interred in Hope cemetery by the side of her husband, the late Joseph E. Bentley, who died twenty-three years ago. Mrs. Bentley came to Ohio from Maryland in 1826, since which time she has resided in this county. She was the mother of thirteen children, five of whom are still living, as follows: Granville S. Bentley, with whom Mrs. Bentley lived, Mrs. Maria Garrigues, of High street, Mrs. Deborah Rice, of Alliance, Caroline Heston, of Palatka, Florida, and Albon Bentley, who resides in Louisiana.

The son Granville, with whom Mrs. Bentley made her home, was but seventeen years younger than his mother, and for the last seventeen years has been totally blind. The Bentleys lived on a fine farm at Green Hill, were renowned for their hospitality and enjoyed the esteem of a large circle of friends. The near relatives in attendance at the funeral were two daughters, seven grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.
