This Indenture made the thirteenth Day of Septem-  
ber, in the 7<sup>th</sup> year of the Dominion of the Right Noble  
Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Province of  
Maryland, Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. and in the Year of  
our Lord God, one thousand Six hundred Eighty and two  
Between Anne Lambert of Ann Arundell County in  
the Province of Maryland of the one part, and Samuel

White of the County and province aforesaid planter of the  
 other part, Whereas the D Anne Lambert is legally  
 Seized and possessed of a ycoll of land in Shickotty Neck  
 Situate, lying and being on the North Side South-River  
 in Anne-Arundell County aforesaid called or known by  
 the Name of Swetts Grounds containing one hundred &  
 thirty Acres more or less. Now this Indenture wit-  
 nesseth that the D Anne Lambert for and in considera-  
 tion of the Sum of three-Thousand pounds of good sound Mer-  
 chantable Gold, in Cash, to her in hand paid by the D  
 Samuel White before the Enfealing and delivery thereof  
 the Receipt whereof the D Anne Lambert doth hereby  
 Acknowledge and to be hereunto fully satisfied and paid  
 and thereof and Every part and ycoll thereof the D Sa-  
 muel White, his Heirs, Exors and Adms: doo acquitt and  
 discharge for Ever, by these yffents, Wills Granted, Bargain-  
 ed, Sold, Aliened, Enfeoffed, and by these yffents doth he  
 himself and his Heirs fully, clearly and absolutely  
 Grant, Bargain, Sell, Alien, Enfeoff and Confirm unto  
 the D Samuel White his Heirs and Assigns for E-  
 ver. And that ypiece or ycoll of Land, being a ypart and ycoll  
 of the abov mentioned Land called Swetts Grounds Sit-  
 uate, lying and being near South-River in the County  
 of Anne-Arundell aforesaid, beginning at a bounded ymo-  
 tree, standing on the West Side of Bear Cove, and Running  
 up the D Bear Cove Branch to a Red-Cork marked  
 1<sup>st</sup> the four Natchers, and from thence by the Draught of the  
 D Branch to a bounded White Oak standing by the  
 D Anne-Lamberts North-East Line, and then Running  
 South-west back with the D Line to a bounded ymo  
 tree standing by the D River, And from thence bounding  
 on the D River to the first bounded tree containing by  
 Estimation Eighty Acres, be they more or less, together  
 with all the Mesuages, Tenements, Houses, dwelling houses

other Trees, Woods and Underwoods, passages, Commodities,  
Easements, Hereditaments, privileges and Exemptions what-  
soever to the Same belonging. Together with all and Singu-  
lar the Estate, Right, Title, Interest, Use, possession pro-  
perty, Inheritance, Claim and Demand whatsoever of  
her the D<sup>ns</sup> Anne Lambert and her Heirs, of, in or to the  
Same, or any part or part thereof, And also all the  
Writings, Deeds, Grants, instruments to the Same belonging  
to have and to hold the Same and Every part and part  
thereof unto him the D<sup>ns</sup> Samuel White his Heirs and  
Assigns for Ever, to and for the only proper use and behoof  
of him the D<sup>ns</sup> Samuel White, his Heirs and Assigns for  
Ever, without the Lett, Suite, Troubles, Eviction, Ejection, dis-  
turbance or hindrance whatsoever of her the D<sup>ns</sup> Anne Lam-  
bert, or any other person or persons whatsoever, And the D<sup>ns</sup>  
Anne Lambert for her-self, her Heirs, Exors: and Adors:  
and Every of them doth Covenant, promise and Grant to  
and with the D<sup>ns</sup> Samuel White his Heirs and Assigns  
and Every of them by those Efforts that sh<sup>al</sup> the D<sup>ns</sup> Anne  
Lambert now at the time of the Enfeoffing and delivery of  
those Efforts, of the Lands and premises hereby bargained  
and of Every part and part thereof, is and standeth  
seized of a good, Sure, firm Title and Estate of Inheri-  
tance in fee Simple, free and clear of all Incumbrances  
whatsoever (the Rents and Services for the Same from this  
time forward to become due and payable to the Lord or  
Lords of the fee only Excepted and appropriated) And that  
sh<sup>al</sup> the D<sup>ns</sup> Anne Lambert hath good Right, full power  
and lawful Authority to Grant, Bargain and Sell

The Same, and Every part and y<sup>ce</sup>ll thereof to him the  
 D<sup>r</sup> Samuel White and Every part and y<sup>ce</sup>ll thereof in man-  
 ner and form as in these y<sup>ce</sup>lls before is expressed. And  
 also that the D<sup>r</sup> Anna Lambert her Heirs and Assigns doe  
 further Covenant, promise and Grant to and with the D<sup>r</sup>  
 Sam<sup>l</sup>: White his Heirs and Assigns by these y<sup>ce</sup>lls, that  
 the D<sup>r</sup> Sam<sup>l</sup>: White his Heirs and Assigns, the D<sup>r</sup> above  
 mentioned Lands, and all and singular the y<sup>ce</sup>lls with-  
 th<sup>r</sup> appurtenances heretofore bargained, or intended to be bargain-  
 ed and granted, shall and may henceforth for ever peace-  
 ably and quietly have, hold, use, occupy possess and Enjoy  
 without the Lett, hindrance, or disturbance of her the D<sup>r</sup>  
 Anna Lambert, her Heirs, Exors: and Adms: or any other  
 y<sup>ce</sup>ll or y<sup>ce</sup>lls whatsoever, And further the D<sup>r</sup> Anna Lam-  
 bert, for her-Self, her Heirs, Exors: Adms: shall at any  
 time or times within the Space of Seven years next fol-  
 lowing the Date hereof at the Reasonable Request, Cost  
 and Charges in the Law of the D<sup>r</sup> Sam<sup>l</sup>: White, his  
 Heirs, Exors: Adms: or Assigns doe make acknowledg-  
 ment, or Cause to be made, done acknowledged or Suffered  
 and Executed all such further Act and Acts, thing and  
 things, Affidavits and Affidavits in the Law whatso-  
 ever to the D<sup>r</sup> Samuel White his Heirs and Assigns, of  
 the above mentioned bargained Lands and y<sup>ce</sup>lls and Ev-  
 ery part and y<sup>ce</sup>ll thereof, as by the said Sam<sup>l</sup>: White  
 his Heirs and Assigns or his or their Councille learned in  
 the Law shall reasonably advise, advise or Required, And  
 Lastly it is mutually Agreed by and between both the  
 parties to these y<sup>ce</sup>lls that all and every such further  
 Affidavits and Affidavits as aforesaid to be made of the  
 D<sup>r</sup> heretofore granted Lands and y<sup>ce</sup>lls or any part or  
 y<sup>ce</sup>ll thereof with the Appurtenances shall to and Ever

Assembly in that behalf provided, did acknowledge the lands  
mentioned to be bargained, granted in the within Written

White, as those lands which the D<sup>r</sup> Sam<sup>l</sup> White hath of  
the gift of the D<sup>r</sup> Anne Lambert and from her heirs -
