and the said Robert M Fleming for himself his heirs executors and administrators doth  
further covenant and agree to and with the said Burgess Millett his heirs and assigns  
that he the said Robert M Fleming and his heirs the above described land and premises  
unto the said Burgess Millett his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and defend a-  
gainst all persons whatsoever claiming or to claim the same by by from or under him them  
or any of them In Testimony whereof the said Robert M Fleming hath hereunto set his  
hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above written Signed Sealed and  
delivered in presence of Ben Ray John Fleming Robert M Fleming

signs forever according to the purport true intent and meaning thereof and the act of assembly  
in such case made and provided Acknowledged before Ben Ray John Fleming

At the request of George Williams the following Bill of Sale was Recorded the 27<sup>th</sup> day of July  
1811 to wit Know all men by these presents that William Butler of montgomery county and  
State of maryland for and in consideration of the sum of twenty dollars current money to me  
in hand paid by George Williams of the county and state aforesaid at and before the sealing  
and delivery hereof the use whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold  
and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said George Williams his executors  
administrators and assigns one feather bed bedstead and furniture one cotton wheel two  
chairs one chest one iron pot and one pig all which property is now in my possession To have  
and To hold the same described property above bargained and sold to the said George Wil-  
liams his executors administrators and assigns forever to his and the only proper use and  
benefit and If he said William Butler for myself my executors and administrators shall  
and will warrant and forever defend by these present to the said George Williams his exe-  
cutors administrators and assigns the said described property against me my executors  
and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever claim-  
ing the same or any part thereof In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and  
affixed my seal this 27<sup>th</sup> day of July 1811 Signed Sealed & delivered in the presents of  
Jepod each Camden Riley William Butler  
Montgomery County to wit On this 27<sup>th</sup> day of July 1811 personally appeared William
