Judicial district, and being duly Sworn on the holy Evangel of Almighty God, do:
depose, saith and declareth as follows, to wit. That he served as a Commissioned
Officer in the War of the Revolution until the end thereof, on the Continental Estab:
lishment; That he entered the Service in the Maryland Line in the Year seven:
teen hundred and Seventy six, That his Commission as Ensign in that Year, has
been lost, having been taken with his Baggage, at Camden in South Carolina, -

That he obtained a Commission as Captain Lieutenant dated the thirtieth day of
November in the Year seven hundred and Seventy nine, and another Commission
as Captain dated the twenty first day of April in the Year seven hundred
and Eighty, both in the Second Maryland Regiment, and both of which are now in
his possession, that he remained in the same Regiment until the Conclusion
of the Revolutionary War, holding the said Commission as Captain; The said
John Gasaway further deposes, saith and declareth under oath as aforesaid, that
from his reduced Circumstances, and being much afflicted with the Rheumatism,
He needs the Assistance of his Country for Support. -
