

es for three Days, without Hat, Cap, or Shoes, by which his Flesh was tore in a sad Manner. All the Time I was in the Bay I was forced to have my Boat mann'd, and to be continually under Arms, which has put me to great Expence. The Day before my Departure, arrived in the Bay a Vessel from New York, escaped by Favour of Night; she called at the Musqueto Shore, and brought News that the two Vessels I saw the Spaniards chase, they took, which was Capt. Mosley, bound to Rhode Island, with 180 Tons of Wood, and a fine new Sloop, Bermudas built, belonging to Governor Pitt, with 150 Tons of Wood; that the Spaniards had landed the Men there; that Governor Pitt sent a Flag of Truce, with Offers to ransom the Sloop, but they would not part with her on any Account, being so fit for their Purpose. They gave an Account of the Engagement they had with me, and swore I should not escape them, as they knew the Baccalu Men would prevent my being loaded so soon. Thus I had a narrow Escape, and it is almost impossible for any Vessel to escape their Sight; and being encouraged by the many Vessels they take, they will soon grow more formidable, and prevent any Ships trading there."
