May 17. ANNAPOLIS.

Last Friday died, after a very long and lingering Illness, at the House of Jonas Green, where he had lived upwards of Eleven Years, and next Day was decently inter'd, Mr. BENJAMIN WOOD, Printer, aged 38, born at Tave in Lincolnshire: He had a good Education, well understood the learned Languages, and was an ingenious and skilful Artist.

Several Times this Week, a large wild Bear has been seen in the Woods on the North Side of Severo, about 7 Miles from this Town, and has paid his Visits to several Plantations, and borrow'd Hogs &c. There has not been seen one in that Neighbourhood for many Years before.

It is imagined he is gone towards Philadelphia, or followed a Woman, whom he has kept Company with, to Maryland.
