That none of the People left the Vessel till rear Midnight, when Captain M'cherson, a Passenger, and sour more, jump'd into one of the Boats, and row'd to a larger Boat, that lay at Anchor at a small Distance, and fent her back to bring off some of the rest; but by the Time it return'd, the Ship was thrown on her Broadfide, and every Soul wash'd off the Decks; so that the eight which were then fav'd, were hanging by the Masts and Tackle, some of them almost dead. And that the Cap tain's Son, on seeing Captain M'Pherson get into the Boat, went to his Father, and intreased him the Boat, went to his Father, and intreased him to leave the Vessel; which he refusing to do, the poor Lad immediately stript, and threw himself into the Water, in hopes of being able to reach the Boa', but was never after feen.
