THE Court has just pronounced a Sentence, which being joined in our Ports, besides a number of flat-bottomed boats more than sufficient to carry them to England and Scotland, which were sent to us about three weeks ago, notwithstanding, in the Middle of this Month we received with Regret, that the Prince of Denmark had been appointed to the Command on the Coast of the North Sea. We know his Protections, and doubtless the Fruit of her Intrigues. *Prince Ferdinand's Head Quarters*. We remain quiet in our Quarters, and have received an Account, that the King of Denmark, with a large Body of Troops, are in his Operations by Lieutenant *de la Motte*, attacked, on the 2d of *October*, the town of *Duderstadt*, which is at the distance of 100 Miles from the *Prince's* Cantonments. *General Mansberg* was posted there, and necessary to quit the Town, (which he did) and to take Possession of *Copenhagen*, where he maintained a garrison of 1000 Men, till the arrival of the *Generals Kielmansegg* and *his Succour*, who, the next day, drove the French in *Duderstadt*, drove them to the sea, and pursued them as far as *Wittenberg*. The loss of the Enemy upon this occasion, is not known. Some of their own Accounts, to 6000 Men have been made Prisoners. The three complete Companies of *the Regiment of the King's Grenadiers*, is at *Vienna, Jan. 2.* The King of *Prussia* has been rejected from this Court have been rejected. He also sent a Plan of *Pacificating* the *Kingdom of Prussia*, which was examined in Council, with *Verailles*, with Orders to our *Ambassador* to inform the *French Ministry*, that the *Prussian* had looked upon that as a difference, and as no Ways accepted, was determined to risk the *approaching Campaign*; but that *King Christian Majesty* to take such a Campaign may be the last, and could be impossible for her to find another making another.

Brandenburg, Jan. 8. By *Measures* of *Recruits* lately raised, we expect that his *Majesty's* next Campaign with about a *hundred thousand Men*, a good Part ready for Action towards the *East*, is not sooner. Our Strength is not as our Enemies may imagine. It is to be expected that the *King's* Army in this Year, even greater Advantages have reaped since the Beginning of the *War*.
