WARSAW, April 15. It is now certain, that the...

peace will render them unnecessary.

VIENNA, April 18. It is asured that Count Esterhazy...

with the Prussians and the Russians against the Confe...
derates.

HAMBURG, April 24. Letters from Copenhagen ad...
vise, that the Commission of Enquiry has been again...
assembled to interrogate Col. Falkenschild, and that a...
regiment of dragoons is sent to Aalborg to guard...
that castle. These letters add, that during the last...
examination which Count Struensee underwent, he...

that the French King has added considerably to the...
Princess's fortune.

Yesterday orders were given to several of his Ma...
jesty's domesticks, to be in readiness to embark, on the...
first notice, for Copenhagen, to conduct Princess Ca...
rolina Matilda from that place to Zell, in the elec...
trator of Hanover, which is to be her place of resi...
dence.

The same day orders were sent to Capt. Hamilton...
who is appointed to have the command of one capital...
ship and two frigates, to sail to Copenhagen on said...
occasion the first opportunity.

On Thursday the House ordered, that an instruction...

Abstract of a letter from Poonamula, near Madras, dated...
October 8, 1772.

The design of taking Tanjour having been re...
vived, our army marched the 21st of last month to...
wards that place. On the 28th batteries were opened...
against a strong fort called Vellum, seven miles from...
Tanjour. The enemy deserted it the 20th at mid...
night, and we took possession of it the 21st, early in...
the morning. We now hear that the batteries against...
Tanjour are within 500 yards of the place.

May 4. It is now confidently said, that nothing but...
the customary supplies will be demanded from the Par...
liament; and that this advantage is owing to the pru...
dent administration of Lord North, who, besides avoid...
ing the imposition of any new burdens upon the subject...
has paid off 2,800,000l. of the national debt in the...
course of the past winter.

The report of Sir Robert Keith's return from Co...
penhagen, as an intention of hostility against the Danes...
is entirely without foundation. All matters are now...
finally settled between the two Courts, and if Sir Ro...
bert comes over for any time, it will be just as Sir Jo...
seph Yorke has done, merely on his own private af...
fairs, with a view of returning the very first opportu...
nity.

On Sunday morning five loaded waggons, with pro...
visions and other necessaries, were sent away from St...
James's for Deal, to be put on board his Majesty's...
ships destined for the Baltic, to escort her Royal High...
ness Carolina Matilda to Zell, and this morning fe...
veral persons belonging to the Board of Green Cloth...
will set out, to embark on board the said ships for that...
purpose.

Carlton House is now sitting up with great magni...

May 5. Friday last Lord North, in the House of...
Commons, opened the Budget, and it was now known...
that the Treasury are to pay off 1,500,000l. at two...
instalments, namely, 750,000l. on Midsummer day...
all in three per cents; no person is allowed to subscribe...
a greater sum than 10,000l. and every subscribing cre...
ditor is to be paid 90l. for every 100l. three per cents...
and to be indulged with a douceur of four lottery...
tickets. His Lordship declared, that, so far as he...
could obtain any lights into the present system of the...
different courts in Europe, all was PEACE, and no...
thing seemed to hinder this so general a peace from...
continuing ten years, which if it did, and he should...
continue at the head of the Treasury, he proved, from...
uncontrovertible computations, that he should, within...
that period, pay off 17,600,000l. of the national debt;...
and farther, that when this sum should be thus paid...
off, the clear net revenue of this kingdom would a...
mount to six millions annually, which would be a sum...
equal to the undertaking of any war, whether naval or...
military, or both, with all the combined powers of...
Europe. His Lordship observed, that the King of...
France was equally solicitous for a peace, and that al...
though many British officers, both in the navy, and ar...
my, might very naturally wish for war, in order to...
signalize their superior courage and abilities; yet it...
was the special duty and province of a First Lord...
of the Treasury to consider the event either of peace...
or war, not in a partial but in a general light; adding...
that he had considered it in the latter point of view;...
and though he was as highly sensible of the abilities...
of his Majesty's naval and military forces as any person...
in the kingdom, yet, upon a comprehensive and gene...
ral view of things, he was clearly convinced, that it...
was the advantage of this kingdom not to go into war...
unless absolutely compelled so to do, which hitherto...
had not been the case, since, whenever his Majesty...
thought the honour of his Crown any ways insulted...
the insulters had always made ample acknowledgment...
and confession.

The state of the nation, with which Lord North on...
Friday acquainted the Parliament at the opening of the...
Budget, is such as must give universal satisfaction...
to the people, however interested writers may endeavour...
to shew us the happiness of being miserable; our pub...
lick debt is reduced, our fleet is in a formidable situa...
tion, our army well disciplined, and unanimity once...
more happily re-established among us: these are real...
blessings, and, if the opening of the ports shall fortun...
ately produce a plenty of provisions, we shall reach...
the summit of political happiness, in spite of foreign...
foes and domestic incendiaries.

We are informed, that this morning his Excellency...
the Russian Ambassador notified in form to our Court...
that a suspension of arms has actually taken place be...
tween the Turks and Russians, and that a congress is...
already begun.

Some letters from Paris mention, that orders have...
been sent to the French commander in the Mediterra...
nean to sail for Algiers, to demand satisfaction for...
some indignities lately offered to the French consul at...
that place.

May 6. One of the famous modern Nabobs was fre...
quently heard to declare, some time ago, that, during...
one year, while he was in the East Indies, his income...
was equal to four hundred pounds a day. What an im...
mense sum for a private coffer! and how many poor...
Indians must have bled for it! This honest gentleman...
now dreading the eagle-eyed Committee who are scru...

May 7. Lord North had some conversation yesterday...
with a foreign Minister, who asked him why he was so...
strongly wedded to an opinion, that the general paci...

of Europe would continue ten years? His Lord...
ship answered, that if the various powers of Europe...
really knew their own interest, there never would be...
another war, but that policy itself would become a...
guarantee to the rights of humanity.

A gentleman who arrived on Sunday night last from...
Paris brings advice, that the French King has been...
attacked with a sudden illness, from which it is thought...
he cannot recover.

Abstract of a letter from Copenhagen, dated April 28.

Saturday last, early in the forenoon, the Commit...
tee of Enquiry pronounced sentence against John Fre...
derick Struensee and Enevold Brandt, which was ac...
cordingly presented to the Privy Council without his...
Majesty's attendance. In the afternoon the Privy...
Council met again; in the evening, towards seven...
o'clock, the King arrived from Charlottenburgh, and...
presided at the Council Board, when, after confirm...
ing the sentence, he went directly to the Italian opera.

Same day, at twelve at noon, both the prisoners...
were acquainted by their Counsellors with their sen...
tences. Struensee received and read it with extraor...
dinary composure, which naturally astonished all those...
present; to whom he observed, they ought, as he did...
to impute it to his constant apprehensions and his...
long preparations for his unhappy fate. His un...
easiness appeared much greater, when he found Brandt's...
sentence equal to his own. Brandt also seemed tolera...
bly resigned on hearing his sentence; but the follow...
ing morning his spirits totally sunk, there being no...
barber sent him, as usual, to be shaved. Mess. Mun...
ter and Itce have been, since Saturday, seldom absent...
from Struensee and Brandt. Both prisoners deliv...
ed to their Counsellors hands, on their leaving them on...
Saturday last, two letters, one for the King and one...
for the Committee of Enquiry. Yesterday they both...
took the Holy Sacrament.

Struensee's sentence takes up five full sheets of pa...
per: Among the charges therein contained against...
him are, his having assumed too great a power to him...
self; his injuring the King's treasure for more than...
fifteen tons of gold; his forging (or falsifying) a...
draught; his discharging the guards; the suspicious...
arrangements he had been ordering within the walls of...
this place, &c.

Brandt's sentence expressly says, that, on account...
of his designs agitated immediately against the sacred...
person of his Majesty, the exceptions he made could...
not be admitted, and therefore declared guilty and...
condemned. Towards the conclusion of their sentence...
is added, in virtue of the Danish Law Book, B, VI...
Cap. IV. Art. 2. both Count John Frederick Struensee...
and Count Enevold Brandt, having made them...
selves guilty, and as an example to others, stand justly...
condemned to forfeit their honours, lives, and pro...
perty; and are entirely degraded from the dignities...
belonging to their titles of Earls; their Earls coats of...
arms are to be broken by the hands of the common...
hangman; this being done, their right arm will be...
cut off, next their heads, then will their bodies be...
quartered and laid upon the wheel, and their heads...
and hands fixed upon iron spikes.

The aforesaid dead warrants were this morning...
executed in a field without the eastern gate; a scaffold...
was erected of nine yards in height and eight yards...
square, whither both the prisoners were carried in...
hackney coaches; in the first went the Attorney Ge...
neral, and some attendants; Brandt appeared first on...
the scaffold, he had on a gold laced hat, a green suit...
of cloaths, with gold binding, and boots; he spoke...
for some little time to his clergyman Mr. Hee, after...
which the sentence was read and executed; his head...
was several times exposed to the view of an immense...
crowd of spectators. Next appeared Struensee on the...
scaffold, accompanied by Dr. Munter, having his hat...
in his hand, and dressed in a blue superfine suit; he...
spoke to Dr. Munter; when done, his sentence was...
executed in every shape like the foregoing one; their...
corpses were carried to the usual place of execution...
to be there exposed; Struensee behaved very penitently...
but this cannot be said of Brandt, for his whole con...
duct was remarkably bold; several files of soldiers and...
sailors guarded the scaffold, and the town guards were...
also reinforced; though immense numbers were, for...
want of room, disappointed of seeing this execution...
and all seeming for a while in a violent ferment, yet...
the whole went off undisturbed and quietly.

Notwithstanding the late peaceable professions of...
Lord North in an august assembly, the following cir...
cumstance, we can assure the publick, is a fact, that...
there are just now ordered from Deal to Sheerness, to...
be ready for sea at an hour's notice, three 74 gun ships...
two bomb ketches, a fire ship, and a yacht. Where...
this fleet is destined is no doubt uncertain; still it...
