Mr. WILLIAM HODGE, of Baltimore, near the market-house on Howard's Hill, he is about 28 or 30 years of age, 5 feet 6 inches high, of a dark complexion; his clothing is a white broad cloth coat, black cloth jacket, osnabrig shirt, thickest breeches, old stockings, and old shoes, has lost three toes off his left foot, and the great toe off his right foot, and has a scar over his right eye. The other committed on February 1st, by the name of PETER, but since says his name is MATY, and that he belongs to Mr. BATTLE MUSE,

of Berkeley county, State of Virginia, he is about 5 feet 5 inches high, 35 years of age, and chunky built; his clothing is a dark coarse cloth coat, striped cotton under jacket, osnabrig shirt, and thickest breeches, a pair of white yarn stockings, a pair of shoes, and an old hat. Their masters are desired to come and take them away in two months from their several dates, or they will be sold for their prison fees and other expences according to law.
