of Berkeley county, State of Virginia, he is about 5 feet 5 inches high, 35 years of age, and chunky built; his clothing is a dark coarse cloth coat, striped cotton under jacket, otinabrig shirt, and thickset breeches, a pair of white yarn stockings, a pair of shoes, and an old hat. Their makers are desired to come and take them away in two months from their several dates, or they will be sold for their prison fees and other expenses according to law.
