FOREIGN.

NEW-YORK, AUG. 25. From the New York Gazette. FROM ENGLAND. The ship Herald, Price, sailed from Liverpool the 9th of July.

The captain and passengers inform us, the opinion was prevalent in England that there would be war with this country.

REAR ADMIRAL Sir Joseph York, with three 74's a frigate and a sloop, sailed from Portsmouth the 3th July, for the coast of America.

LONDON, JULY 4. The Holly schooner arrived yesterday at Portsmouth from Bermuda, with despatches from adm. Sawyer, containing captain Bingham's account of the late affair between the Little Belt and the American frigate President.

It is not only the general opinion in the circles of government, that the U. States are disposed to hostilities with this country, but a declaration to this effect has been made by one of the members of the cabinet in a private company.
