Janet Watson.

The following letter, says the Sa... vannah Republican, was addressed... to John Mix, Esq. commander of... the ship Ceres, who politely handed... it to the Editors for publication. The... source from whence it comes, en... titles it to serious consideration:
Port-au-Prince, Feb. 23d, 1817.

"Dear Sir,
It may not be amiss on your ar... rival at Savannah, to give publicity... to the following facts, which have... so recently occurred here, & which... if not noticed by the government of... the United States, will be attribut... ed by the Haytians to the want of... nerve: They openly and boldly de... ny our having the means to resent... any outrage, however atrocious it... might be.

On the 20th instant, James Wat... son, an American seaman, (accused... of having killed in the afternoon of... the preceding day, 19th, a black... man, on board the American brig... Merchant, captain Burnham) was... shot by order of a military tribunal... in the presence of — soldiers, marched out to witness the murder... ous act. Six soldiers were chosen... for this horrible purpose—four of... them fired and Watson fell dead on... the spot; the remaining two, whose... muskets missed fire in the in... stance, again took aim, and their... muskets missed fire — appointed and engaged, they rush... ed upon their victim, pierced his... lifeless corpse with their bayonets; and... finally discharged the contents of their... muskets through the head of the de... ceased—Watson died like a brave... man, and deserved a better fate.—... Counsel was employed to defend him... —nothing, however, would be heard... in his defence, nor leav... ed him to produce his witnesses, his... comrades of the brig Merchant. Pet... ion was petitioned to order a re... vision of the sentence; his answer... was, that the deceased had killed a... soldier and must suffer death.—No... thing could save him, and in the... short space of twenty four hours, he... was accused, arrested and shot; for... trial he had none.

"The circumstances which led to... the death of the Haytian, are as follows:
"On the 18th, two soldiers went... on board the brig Merchant, and, as... is customary with them whenever... they have an opportunity, committed... a theft. Having succeeded so well, they... returned the following day, the 19th, when... the mate (who together with all hands, were... at work in the hold, and the captain... being on shore) ordered James... Watson and — to go up and drive... away the intruders. — took a... rope's end, with which he struck... one of them; Watson took up a... stove, and struck the other on the... buttocks, who to avoid a second... blow, which he had reason to ap... prehend precipitately retreated; but... in his haste, his foot slipped when... he fell into his own boat alongside... and broke his neck. This was Wat... son's own statement; it is plausible... and very probably the fact; but, true... or false, he should have had a... trial—a fair trial, he had no trial at... all, and was in plain English, MUR... DERED. I am, sir, your most o... bedient servant, &c."
