This remedy... laudanum. If the symptoms a... extremely severe, no refer... should be had to measuring its qu... tity—let it be poured into the pa... ent's mouth by the spoonful. I... case be not extreme, a tea-spoon... administered every 5 or 10 minut... until relief is procured, will suff... This remedy is always at hand... and no time need be lost. But it... be observed, that in this case... least, camphor was effectual, a... therefore it deserves to be tried... gain.
