WHEAT.

A respectable correspondent informs us, that unslacked lime has been found to answer an excellent use, in preparing wheat for seed. A gentleman states that he put four or five pounds of quick into a sufficient quantity of water to soak one bushel of wheat. It showed the last spring, then it was sown in a field, and the wheat, and permitted it to stand about twelve hours. The soil being raised the temperature of the water to blood heat, & wheat became soft and apparent boiled. On sowing it, however, began to sprout much sooner than usual, flourished remarkably, produced an excellent crop, and free from any appearance of mildew.

TO FARMERS.

The practice of sowing wheat on wet sod, with one ploughing has been much recommended both in England and the United States as attended with complete success in raising good crops, and also in trying the experiment, failed altogether by ploughing shallow, by which the grass and weeds are not completely destroyed, and the field may be broken up in the eighth month, the manure applied immediately, and well harrowed in—and then in proper season ploughed lightly, & sown a bushel to the acre. This management the wheat will in the fall and generally produces a good crop of clean grain in the spring. Note, the more the soil is turned down, the better it will be well covered. Ibid.
