VOLCANO OF CLAY. A very remarkable phenomenon has lately attracted the Sicilians and travellers to the eastern declivity of Etna. It is a volcano of clay, which has burst forth in a plain at 200 paces from the sea. The crater does not exceed two and a half feet; the clay it spouts up, rises six or seven feet and spreads itself in such a manner, that at a mile's distance it forms a marsh of slosh. This clay is excellent for pottery.
