Resolved, That it appears to this House, by the removal of Philip B. Travilla, as a member of this House, for Allegany county, who claims a right to a seat in this House, in the place of Hugh Wallis, who was returned by the Judges of Elections in said county, as one of the four who had received the greatest number of legal votes, that several votes or ballots were delivered to said Judge, printed in masser and form following, viz: Legitimate source of all political power is the people.
