BY-LAW.

A By-Law to repeal the tenth section of a By- Law to establish and regulate Fire Companies. Passed July 11, 1831.

BY-LAW.

BE it established and ordained by the Mayor, Recorder, Aldermen, and Common Councilmen of the City of Annapolis, that the tenth section of the By-Law to establish and regulate fire companies, appropriating to the use of the fire companies the sum of fifty dollars per annum, be and the same is hereby repealed.
