MARYLAND LEGISLATURE.
HOUSE OF DELEGATES.
WEDNESDAY, Dec. 28th, 1831.

The House met.—Present the same members as yesterday.

Joseph A. Turner, Esq. a delegate returned for Charles county; Davis Richardson, Esq. a delegate returned for Frederick county; and Jacob Lantz, Esq. a delegate returned for Allegany county, severally appeared, qualified, and took their seats.

The message adopted by this House on yesterday, proposing the appointment of a joint committee of both houses, to wait on his Excellency, the Governor, and inform him that they were prepared to receive any communication which he might deem necessary to make, was sent to the Senate.

The Clerk of the Senate delivered the following message: By the Senate, Dec. 27th, 1831. Gentlemen of the House of Delegates.

The Senate has received your message of the 24th, proposing to appoint a joint committee to contract for the public printing, and has approved the same.

Also a communication from Samuel Sands, of the city of Baltimore, relative to the public printing, which were read.

Mr. Hunt presented the petition of Nicholas Radfemur, and others, of the city of Baltimore, praying that the owners of property on the bed of Division street, and two alleys laid down parallel therewith, may be allowed damages for improvements erected thereon.

Mr. Lawrenson presented the memorial of Fielding Lucas, Jr. of the city of Baltimore, relative to a map of the state.

Mr. Lantz presented the petition of sundry citizens of Allegany county, praying for the erection of a bridge across Will's creek, at the mouth of Braddock's run, in said county.

Mr. Hunt submitted the following preamble and order, which were twice read and adopted.

Resolved, That the committee on public printing be instructed to inquire into the practicability of having the laws of the present session distributed at an early period after the adjournment of the legislature.

The Clerk of the Senate delivered the following message: By the Senate, Dec. 28th, 1831. Gentlemen of the House of Delegates.

We have appointed Messrs. Taney and Sappington, to join the gentlemen named by your house, to wait upon the Governor.
