THE MAINE BORDER TROUBLE. LATE AND IMPORTANT FROM HALIFAX.

The late news from the State of Maine has such a warlike appearance that it is the general opinion that war cannot now be averted between the two countries. We shall particularly lament if the good and kindred feeling that ought to prevail should now be broken up, and hope that it may still blow over. Our Legislature yesterday immediately on the receipt of the intelligence, voted a sum not exceeding One Hundred Thousand Dollars, to be at the disposal of the Governor, to assist the Mother Country to raise volunteers to go to the assistance of our Sister Province, and eight thousand men will be raised immediately.

HIGHLY IMPORTANT FROM N. BRUNSWICK. The Frederick Sentinel, received this day, confirms the account given on Monday, of hostile movements by the State of Maine, and in addition gives the message of the Governor to the Legislature, commanding a levy of 10,000 men, for the purpose of taking possession of the territory in dispute, and to enable him to carry this measure into effect, the Legislature have voted the sum of eight hundred thousand dollars, and passed resolutions calling upon the State of Massachusetts to aid them in the measure.

Notwithstanding the suddenness of the measures adopted by the House, when the doors were opened at half past five o'clock, the lobby and gallery were filled to overflowing, by the crowds of inhabitants who had been waiting for admission. The report was then read, after some preliminary observations, by the Hon. Mr. Dadd, Chairman of the committee.

Whereas, it was the great object of our union, that every question involving controversy between any single State and a foreign government, should be deemed of equal moment to her sisters confederate; and whereas the late intelligence of the manifest design on the part of the authorities of the Colony of New Brunswick, in defiance not only of actual right, but of stipulations well understood to exercise exclusive jurisdiction over a portion of territory claimed by the State of Maine, to which the title of the British Government is worse than doubtful;—the furtherance of which unjust purpose, the citizens of a sovereign sister State, have in the exercise of their lawful authority been arrested by armed bands, dragged like felons to prison—and the laws of that State and the Union been set at naught—presents a case in which in the opinion of this Assembly, it becomes every member of our confederacy to speak out—therefore.

Be it Received by the General Assembly of Maryland, That we view with regret and indignation, the recent claim set up by the agents of a foreign government to exercise exclusive jurisdiction over a portion of territory, which although at present in dispute, of right belongs solely to the State of Maine.
