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## **Hotel Shooting Suspect Not Under Probation Supervision**

TOWSON, MD (December 7, 2009)--- One of the suspects involved in a shooting at a Baltimore hotel over the weekend was incorrectly identified as being on probation supervision with the Maryland Division of Parole and Probation at the time of the incident.

Raymond Woodland was sentenced to three years probation in February of 2009, but this case was closed in July of 2009 at the conclusion of a violation of probation hearing during which Woodland was sentenced by the District Court of Baltimore to serve seven months imprisonment as a result of that violation, with no further supervision required upon completion. The Division of Parole and Probation closed its case regarding the February 2009 probation sentence accordingly. Mr. Woodland was released from the Baltimore City Detention Center in October following completion of the seven month sentence.
