## **84.345 U.S. DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION OFFICE OF POST SECONDARY EDUCATION UNDERGROUND RAILROAD EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL PROGRAM**

**Program Description:** Provides funds to research and educational organizations that are established to research, display, interpret and collect artifacts relating to the history of the underground railroad.

**Formula Description:** An agreement documenting the commitment of the organization to provide matching funds for support of the project in an amount equal to four times the amount of the contribution of the federal government is required.
