Dual Enrollment in Maryland

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Executive Summary

The Maryland Longitudinal Data System Center (MLDSC) is required to report annually on the number of students who are dually enrolled and the courses in which they are enrolled. This report, required under the *College and Career Readiness and College Completion Act of 2013* (CCR-CCA) (see Education Article § 24-703.1, Annotated Code of Maryland), is the eighth MLDS Center Report.

The data for this report comes from the Maryland Longitudinal Data System (MLDS). The MLDS is Maryland's central repository for student education and workforce data. Students were identified in the System as dually enrolled if they were enrolled in both a public high school and a college in Maryland, and had at least one overlapping day of enrollment in both institutions.

A total of 15,691 Maryland public high school students were dually enrolled in the 2018-2019 academic year. This is approximately a 15% increase from the prior year. Maryland community colleges were the most common location for students accessing dual enrollment opportunities. Course information is reported from Maryland public high schools. The MLDS does not currently receive college course information. Students accessed courses in a variety of subject areas. The highest numbers of courses with dual enrollment were in the subjects of English Language and Literature, Social Sciences and History, and Mathematics.

Dual enrollment participation varied widely across the state. This is a reflection of the unique and varied opportunities for dual enrollment in each school system. The data presented in this report identifies trends in dual enrollment that policymakers and other stakeholders can evaluate to understand the impact of CCR-CCA on dual enrollment in Maryland.

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Section 1. Background and Introduction

A. Report Requirements

Under the *College and Career Readiness and College Completion Act* (CCR-CCA), the Maryland Longitudinal Data System (MLDS) Center is required to submit to the Governor and the General Assembly an annual report on dual enrollment in Maryland (see Education Article §24-703.1, Annotated Code of Maryland). Specifically, the report is required to provide the following information, disaggregated by local system:

- (1) The number of students who are dually enrolled under Title 18, Subtitle 14A of this article; and
- (2) The number and course name of the courses in which a student under item (1) of this section dually enrolls at the high school and at the public institution of higher education.

This report is the eighth MLDS Center report on Dual Enrollment and the seventh that utilizes data directly from the Maryland Longitudinal Data System. Prior reports are available on the MLDS Center Website.¹ The current report includes dual enrollment data for the 2018-2019 academic year.

B. About the MLDS

The Maryland Longitudinal Data System is the State’s central repository for student education and workforce data provided by the Center’s partner agencies. The MLDS Center develops and maintains the System in order to provide analyses and produce relevant information on student and workforce outcomes in Maryland.

C. What is dual enrollment?

Dual enrollment refers to any broad array of programs and opportunities that allow high school students to enroll in and take college courses. This includes programs in which students are enrolled in a dual enrollment course through a partnership agreement with their local school system and thereby receive both high school and college credit. Dual enrollment also occurs when high school students independently enroll in courses at a college and only earn college credits. Dual enrollment courses can be completed in a variety of different ways, including:

- High school students traveling to college campuses or college faculty traveling to high schools;
- Specially credentialed high school teachers teaching college-level courses to students in local high schools; or
- High school students taking courses from college instructors via distance education.

D. Definition of Dual Enrollment

The CCR-CCA (Md. Code, Ed. Art. §18-14A-01) defines dual enrollment broadly. “Dually enrolled student” means a student who is dually enrolled in:

- (i) A secondary school in the State; and
- (ii) An institution of higher education in the State.

The MLDS Center does not have the data necessarily to fully report on dual enrollment as defined by CCR-CCA. Instead, for the purposes of this report, dual enrollment was defined broadly as students who:

- 1. Had overlapping enrollment dates in a Maryland public high school and a Maryland institution of higher education (hereinafter “college”); and
- 2. Were enrolled in the college for at least one day.

Starting with the 2017 report, the criteria for determining which students to count as dually enrolled were revised. The following table provides an explanation of the prior and current criteria.

The revised criteria result in a slight reduction of the number of dually enrolled students as compared to prior criteria. The revised criteria exclude students who were enrolled in college in May immediately prior to high school graduation in June. These students were determined to be enrolled in college rather than dually enrolled in high school and college due to the timing of the enrollment at end of their high school program.

E. Supplemental Information

Prior versions of the *Annual Dual Enrollment Report* contained information that was not directly responsive to the two questions that the Center is statutorily required to answer in this report. Instead of repeating the additional material in each report, or having users search through old reports, the Center has begun a series of dashboards to provide additional information about dual enrollment to help provide a more complete picture of dual enrollment in Maryland. Currently the website contains the following information:

- 1. Statewide Dual Enrollment trends, including:
 - a. Overview of statewide year-over-year dual enrollment numbers;
 - b. Grade level trends;
 - c. Demographic trends – dual enrollment disaggregated by gender, race/ethnicity, and whether the student was eligible for Free and Reduced Price Meals (FARMS);

- d. College enrollment patterns; and
 - e. Dual enrollment by course of study – dual enrollment disaggregated by the course of study completed by the high school student (USM, CTE, USM/CTE, Other and Non-completer); and
2. County Dual Enrollment trends, including:
- a. Overview of the user selected school system’s year-over-year dual enrollment numbers;
 - b. Gender – a comparison of State and user selected local school system dual enrollment by gender;
 - c. Race/Ethnicity – a comparison of State and user selected local school system dual enrollment by race/ethnicity;
 - d. Grade level – a comparison of State and user selected local school system dual enrollment by grade level; and
 - e. College enrollment patterns – a comparison of State and user selected local school system college enrollment patterns of dually enrolled and non-dually enrolled students.

Additional dashboard content is planned for 2021. Background information on national dual enrollment rates and trends, and college enrollment outcomes for dually enrolled student can be found in the [2016 Dual Enrollment Report](#).

Finally, the Center’s Research Branch conducted an in-depth analysis² of the causal effects of dual enrollment on college and workforce outcomes and whether those effects differ by student subgroup. That report’s findings indicated that dually enrolled students were more likely to enroll in college, persist in college, and earn a college degree, including associate, bachelor’s, and certificate degrees, when compared to similar students who were not dually enrolled. Additionally, dually enrolled students had higher annual wages (+\$2,100) six years after high school when compared to similar students who had not been dually enrolled. Dual enrollment had stronger effects for students who are traditionally under-represented in the college population (e.g., Black and Hispanic students and students eligible for free and reduced price meals [FARMS]). The report discusses policy implications and directions for future research on dual enrollment in Maryland.

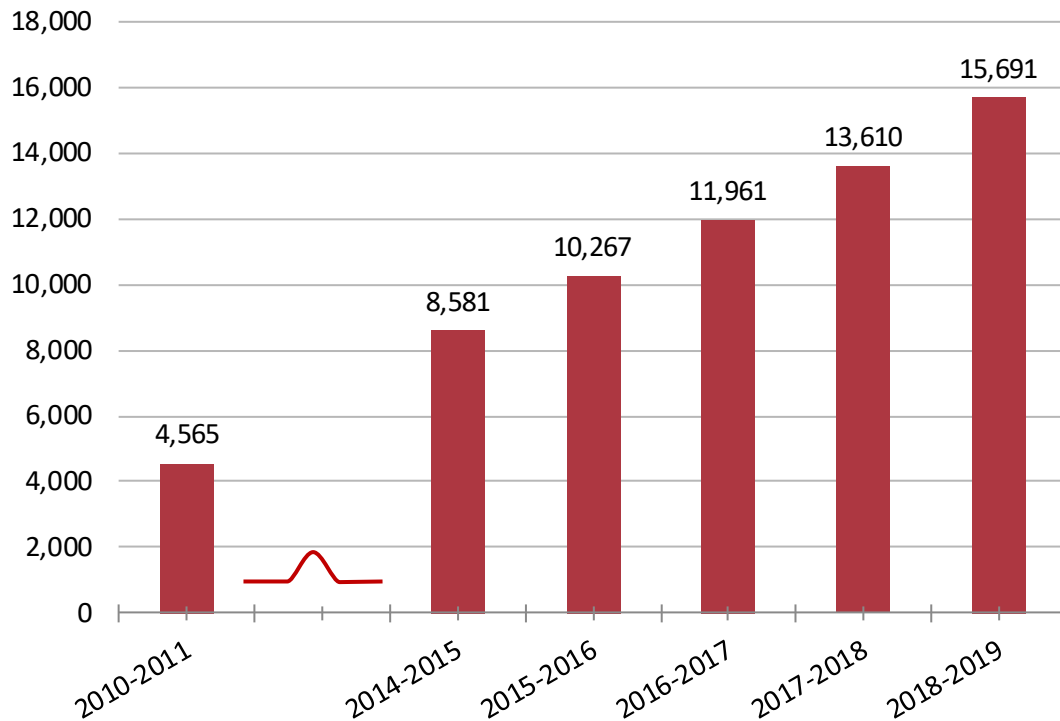

Section 2. Dual Enrollment in Maryland

A. Statewide Dual Enrollment Trends

The number and rate of students dually enrolling in Maryland continues to increase annually. **Figure 1** and **Table 1** provide information on the overall number of dually enrolled students and the rate of dual enrollment (the percentage of all students of who are dually enrolled) from 2010-2011, the first year of reporting, compared to the last five years. A total of 15,691 Maryland public high school students were dually enrolled in 2018-2019, compared to the 4,565 who were dually enrolled in 2011 - an increase of 71%. The current rate of participation means that nearly 6% of all high school students (grades 9 to 12) had a dual enrollment experience in 2018-2019, an increase of 4 percentage points from the 2010-2011 rate.

B. School System Dual Enrollment Trends

All school systems in Maryland participated in dual enrollment, although the rate of participation varied widely. **Table 2** provides the total number and percentage of dually enrolled students by school system for 2010-2011 and 2018-2019⁵. The rate of dual enrollment statewide in 2018-2019 was 5.8%. Garrett County again had the highest dual enrollment rate of 17%, which was nearly three times that of the statewide rate and a 14 percentage point increase from 2010-2011. Allegany, Frederick, Somerset, Washington, and Worcester had dual enrollment rates that doubled or nearly doubled the statewide rate. Notably, Worcester had the largest percentage point increase in dual enrollment rate from last year (from 7.45% to 12.21%), and the second largest increase from 2010-2011 (10 percentage points). Anne Arundel, Baltimore City, Calvert, Dorchester, Kent, St. Mary’s, and Talbot all saw a decrease in the rate of dual enrollment from 2017-2018 to 2018-2019. Most decreases were less than one-half of a percentage point with the exception of Kent County. Kent County had a decrease of almost three percentage points over last year.

The five largest counties continue to have modest dual enrollment rates. Montgomery County and Baltimore City, had the first and second lowest rates of dual enrollment respectively. Anne Arundel County’s rate is higher but still below the statewide percentage. Only Prince George’s County and Baltimore County have a dual enrollment percentage that are slightly above the statewide percentage.

C. College Dual Enrollment Trends

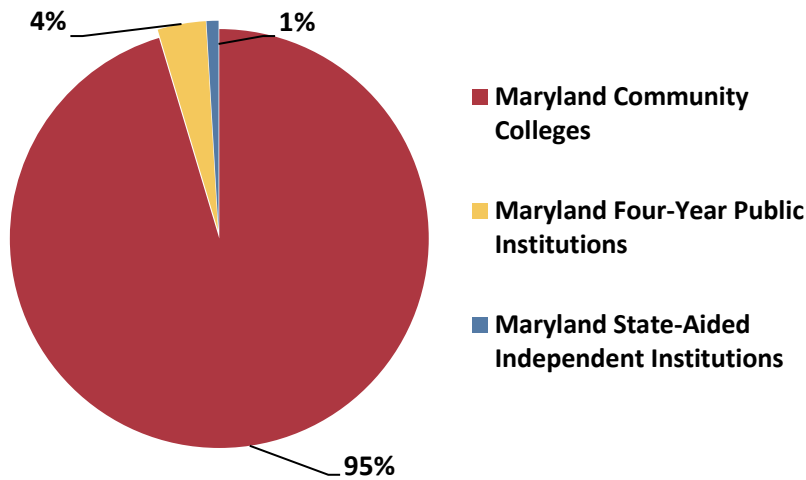


Figure 3: Degree-Seeking Undergraduate College Enrollment Percentage by College Segment, State of Maryland, Fall 2018

The vast majority of dual enrollment is completed at Maryland’s community colleges, which enrolled 95% of all dually enrolled students. **Figure 2** provides data on dual enrollment by college segment. Comparatively, as seen in **Figure 3**, only 38% of all degree-seeking students in Maryland are enrolled in a Maryland community college. **Table 3** provides the specific number of dually enrolled students enrolled in each college in Maryland. Prince George’s Community College has the largest number of dually enrolled students among community colleges and overall. University of Maryland, College Park has the largest number of dually enrolled students among Maryland four-year public Institutions and Johns Hopkins University had the largest number of dually enrolled students among Maryland state-aided independent institutions.

Figure 2: Dual Enrollment Percentage by College Segment, State of Maryland, Fall 2018

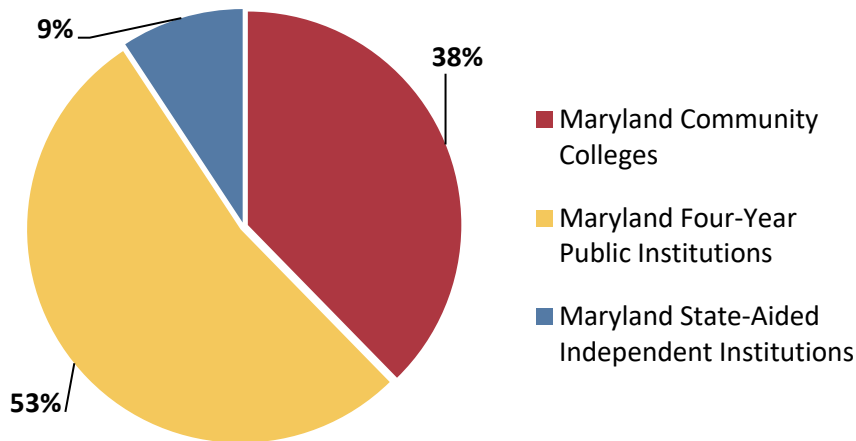

Section 3. Dual Enrollment Course Information

A. Course Information and Availability

There are two sources of course information for dually enrolled students: 1) the high school and 2) the college.

High school course information is available from the Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) for students who dually enrolled through a partnership agreement with the local school system, provided the local school system identified the course as a dual enrollment course.

Fifty-seven percent of Maryland’s dually enrolled students in academic year 2018-2019 had a course that was identified as a dual enrollment course. This is an increase from last year where course information was only available for 48% of students. **Table 4** presents the rate at which courses were identified as taken through partnership agreements for each school system. Course reporting may never equal 100% for two reasons. First, it is possible that courses were taken through partnership agreement but not coded as such in the data. Second, some dually enrolled students take courses in the summer. Those courses are not considered dual enrollment by MSDE and thus would not be coded. Finally, a student could dually enroll not pursuant to the partnership agreement.

College course information from the Maryland Higher Education Commission (MHEC) is not yet available. MHEC began collecting course information from colleges in 2014 and the data were approved for inclusion in the Center’s data inventory this year. At the time of writing this report, the data are still be analyzed and loaded into the MLDS.

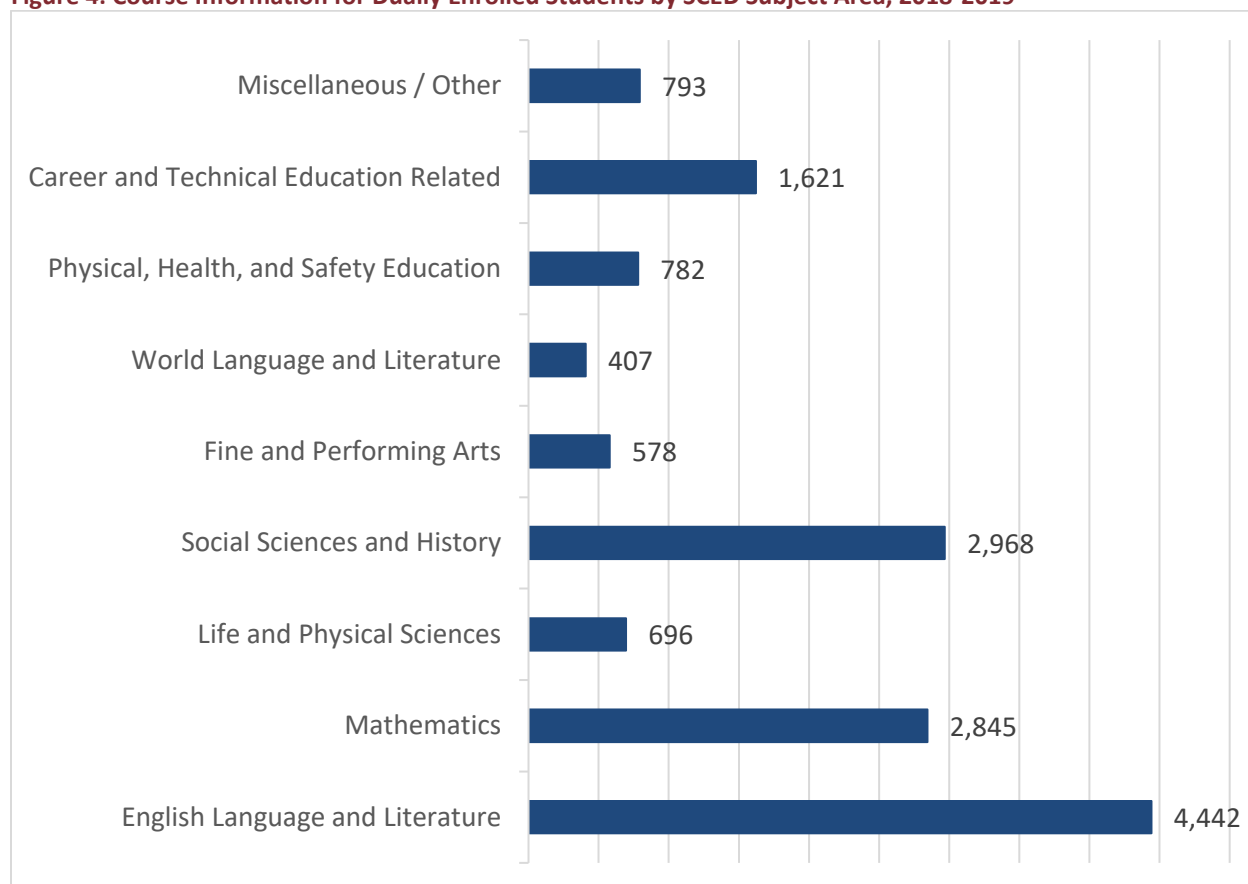

B. Course Subjects

Courses are classified using the School Courses for the Exchange of Data (SCED) classification system. **Figure 4** provides data on the total number of dually enrolled students by SCED across all school systems. There are 18 SCED subject areas. Reported here are the most common subject areas for dual enrollment courses. The remaining SCED subjects were grouped together as a “Miscellaneous/Other” subject area.

Available course data indicate that dual enrollment primarily focused on English, math, and social sciences and history courses. Some students pursued coursework in the arts, foreign languages, career and technical training, and physical, health and safety education. These findings are consistent with prior year analyses⁸ with one exception. In 2015-2016 there were 2,658 students enrolled in Life and Physical Sciences, making it the third largest subject. This year, similar to last year, there are less than 700 dual enrollments in this subject, dropping it to seventh largest. Physical, Health and Safety Education had a similar decline. In 2015-2016 the number of students dually enrolled in in this subject was 1,352; this year the total is 782. The next year (2016-2017), the number decreased to 426. Each

subsequent year, the number of students pursuing this subject has increased: 667 in 2017-2018 and 782 this year. The continued changes may be the result of incomplete and inconsistent course data from several counties; including Anne Arundel, which does not report dual enrollment course records and Harford and Montgomery counties, which have had inconsistent reporting:

- Harford 65% (2015-16) 70% (2016-17) 0% (2017-18) 9% (2018-19)
- Montgomery 11% (2015-16) 0% (2016-17) 58% (2017-18) 59% (2018-19)

Section 4. Conclusion

The Maryland College and Career Readiness and College Completion Act of 2013 (CCR-CCA) sought to expand dual enrollment across the state both by encouraging participation and offering funding to support participation. To that end, both the number and percentage of high school students that were dually enrolled increased again this year. Eighteen school systems experienced gains in dual enrollment in 2018-2019; twelve school systems increased dual enrollment by one to four percentage points, while six increased by less than a percentage point. Seven school systems saw decreases in dual enrollment, with the largest drop at Kent County, which decreased the percentage of dually enrolled students from 7.37% to 4.45%.

CCR-CCA also established rules for the tuition and fees that could be charged to dually enrolled students and created the Early College Access Grant to offer financial support to dual enrollment students. These policies were deemed critical to increasing dual enrollment participation. However, data limitations make evaluating the impact of the CCR-CCA policies difficult.

Most significantly, there is no data point that indicates whether a student is dually enrolled pursuant to a partnership agreement between the local school system and the college. Currently the report relies on overlapping enrollment. However, not all students with overlapping high school and college enrollment are dually enrolled pursuant to a partnership agreement. Some portion of the students may have enrolled in college courses on their own to undertake a course of study not offered at the high school. There are data that indicate if a student is participating in a course designated by the high school as a dual enrollment course. However, that indicator is inconsistently applied and may leave out students who are dually enrolled via a partnership agreement, but not taking a dual enrollment designated course at the high school.

In addition to having a designation that a student is taking a course pursuant to a partnership agreement, it would also be beneficial to have data that provides the students' cost of enrollment and whether the student is receiving an early college access grant to provide additional financial support. Having that information would allow the Center to provide policy makers with information on how financial supports encourage participation in dual enrollment and whether it is expanding access to under-served students.

Finally, there are a variety of different models for providing dual enrollment opportunities to high school students. For example, dual enrollment may require high school students to attend courses at a college. Other models may allow high school students to stay at their high school and have a college professor come to the high school to teach a course or have a high school teacher become authorized by a college to teach a college level course at the high school. The delivery model may have an impact on learning outcomes. It may also impact the ability of economically disadvantaged students to access dual enrollment courses.

Consideration should be given to addressing these data gaps to ensure policy makers are able to get a complete picture of the impact of the policies and investment made in dual enrollment in CCR-CCA.
