Dear Senator Kasemeyer and Delegate Conway:


In accordance with the requirement noted on page 121 of the *Joint Chairmen's Report – Operating Budget, April 2010* on the number of Maryland State Department of Education loaned educator contracts and any conversion of these personnel to regular positions by December 15, 2010, I am submitting this report.

As of December 1, 2010, the Maryland State Department of Education is engaged in 30 loaned educator contracts; thus, of a total of 1,565 MSDE personnel, 30 are loaned educators. The attached listing represents the current census report on loaned educator contracts and includes job function, title, salary, fund source(s) for the contract, first year of the contract and the number of years the loaned educator has been engaged by the state, and whether the educator files a financial disclosure statement.

Twenty loaned educator contracts have been eliminated since last year's December report. Of these, eleven loaned educators have returned to their local school systems. The remaining loaned educators, nine in number, have converted to regular positions. These nine conversions represent the balance of the fifteen PINs created for this purpose in FY 2010; the other six conversions took place prior to the past (December, 2009) reporting date.

The contributions of local experience and expertise that our loaned educators bring to the work of the Department is significant, and we will continue to explore ways in which we can capitalize on these strengths while meeting the goal of limiting their involvement to special, short-term projects, where local talent is a necessity.
