

To the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the District of Columbia.
In accordance with the 9th section of the act of Congress approved April 16. 1862 entitled "an act for the release of certain persons held to service or labor in the District of Columbia" the undersigned Anna McWaring of Montgomery County, Maryland by her committee man Samuel Clements of said County and State files this her statement or schedule.

She avers that a certain negro man named Gabriel, of a light copper color, about fifty years of age, about five feet five inches high, of a light and active form, made free and manumitted by the aforesaid act of Congress is her slave for life, to whose services & labor she is entitled, and for which said slave and his services she claims compensation under the terms of said act of Congress—
