Now therefore I, Philip Francis Thomas Governor of Maryland, have thought proper to pardon the said George W. Campbell and I, Pardon do hereby direct that he be immediately released from imprisonment on account of said offence and grant him a pardon therefor.

State of Maryland, To wit:

Whereas, a certain Sherry Wilson free negro was convicted on Indictment in Queen Anns County Court at May Term, in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine of circulating a book tending to insurrection and sentenced to ten year confinement in the Maryland Penitentiary.

And Whereas, the said Sherry Wilson has been recommended to the clemency of the Governor by the Judges of Queen Anns County Court and by the Board of Directors of the Penitentiary on account of his exemplary character and good behaviour since his imprisonment.

Now therefore, I, Philip Francis Thomas, Governor of Maryland have thought proper to pardon the said Sherry Wilson, and I do hereby direct that he be immediately released from imprisonment on account of said offence, and grant him a pardon therefor.
