—Runaway, between 8 and 9 o'clock at night June 4th, 1844, my three Negroes, viz: HANNAH GOOSEBERRY, JUDEA GOOSEBERRY and STEPHEN GOOSEBERRY.—

Hannah is of a pleasing countenance first rate cook, washer, &c.; she is about 40 years old, very large and stout built; a tooth out in front; the small toe on both feet off, occasioned by frost when young. She is the mother of Judea and Stephen.

The two women have good clothing, calicoes, fancy and black, both alike; they all have new shoes; I believe straw bonnets, trimmed with black ribbon. Judea is about 18 or 19 years of age, very stout, smooth skin, small mouth, and moves slow. Stephen is about 17 or 18 years old, the little finger off at the second joint, caused by playing with a saw when young; his clothing, as well as I can recollect, is a casinet roundabout and pantaloons, dark colour, two striped shirts, with some white ones; he has also a small scar under the left eye, occasioned by play; full, round face, small mouth, and resembles Judea, he walks slovenly; was brought up to house-work, opening oysters, cooking them, &c.

I will give the above reward for the three negroes, or in proportion for either of them, and pay all reasonable expenses, if secured so that I get them again. They were bought from Mr. Siddall about 19 years ago.
