April 28th

The Governor administered the oath prescribed by the act calling the Constitutional Convention to sundry members and officers of the Convention see record of Elective Officers pages one and two.

April 29th

The Governor issued Executive requisition upon the Governor of Virginia for the arrest and return to this State of Philip Stenow charged with the crime of Larceny and appointing William H. Capell the agent for his return. see Docket of Requisitions.

May 3rd

The Governor approved official Bond of James B. Latimer Notary Public and directed his commissioners to issue

May 5th

The Governor issued his requisitions to Hon. Chief Justice Carter of District of Columbia for the arrest and return to this State of a certain Aaron Rollings charged on affidavit with Horse Stealing in Prince Georges County and appointed Judson F. Richardson Sheriff of said County agent for

Same day the Governor appointed and commissioned Robert Fowler Esq. of Baltimore County and Valentine Forman and Thomas H. Mules Esq. of Baltimore City Commissioners under act of 1864 chapter 384 for removal of Western Hay Scales.

May 6th

The Governor issued two requisitions upon Hon. D. R. Carter Chief Judge of the Supreme Court of District of Columbia for the arrest and return of John Kemp charged on indictments and affidavits with enticing slaves to run away from their owners in Prince Georges County.

Also two requisitions on the Governor of Virginia as follows vizt.

- 1 For negro Newry Norton charged on indictment and affidavit with a similar
