 This deed, made this fifth day of August in the year
 one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven, by me Emanuel
 Koorly Trustee, Winchester, whereas by a decree of the Circuit
 Court for Carroll County sitting as a Court of Equity passed
 on the third day of July, in the year eighteen hundred and sixty six, in the case of
 Emanuel Koorly versus Margaret A. Koorly, doth the said Emanuel Koorly
 was appointed trustee to sell the land decreed to be sold and have sold the same to Henry
 K. Harbaugh of Carroll County in the State of Maryland, who has fully paid the purchase
 money thereof. Now therefore, in consideration of the above recited premises and of the
 sum of nineteen hundred dollars, the receipt of which the said Emanuel Koorly
 Trustee doth acknowledge, the said Emanuel Koorly Trustee do grant unto Henry K.
 Harbaugh, all the right and title of all the parties to the aforesaid cause, in and to the
 all that lot or parcel of land situated on the Main Street in the West end of the City of
 Westminster, in said County and State, fronting on Main Street in said City sixty feet
 running back one hundred and eighty one and a half feet to an alley consisting of one
 quarter of an acre of land, more or less, being part of the lot described in a deed from
 Christian Rayer and wife to Jacob Weaving, and recorded among the Land Records
 of Carroll County, in Liber A. B. B. No. 15, folio 234, and the whole of lot described in deed from
 David Capell wife to Jacob Weaving, recorded among the Land Records of Carroll County
 in Liber G. O. W. No. 33, folio 348, as by reference to said deeds will fully appear, it being
 also the same lot and premises which are in the occupancy of the said Henry K. Harbaugh
 at this time.

 Amos Bell, William Lowry, George W. Bell, Lewis Charlton, William
 Parker of the County and State of aforesaid, Trustees in trust for the uses and purposes hereinafter
 mentioned of the other part, Winchester, that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
 and fifty dollars the said Amos Bell and Rebecca Bell his wife do grant unto them the said
 John W. Snowden, Amos Bell, William Lowry, George W. Bell, Lewis Charlton, William
 Parker and Nicholas Parker and their successors Trustees, in trust for the uses and purposes
 hereinafter mentioned and declared all that piece or parcel of land, part of a tract of
 land called "Sammy's Meadow", situate lying and being in the City of Westminster
