

## The Old Waring Homestead Burned.

ROCKVILLE, Md., April 13.—The residence of the late Henry B. Waring, "Norway," Waring Station, Montgomery county, Md., was entirely destroyed by fire on Monday night, the 8th instant, between 11 and 12 o'clock. This was one of the oldest homesteads in the county, and has been in the Waring family more than a century. It was the country seat of the late Henry Waring, of Georgetown, D. C., father of Henry B. Waring and grandfather of the present heirs.
