In the name of God Amen. I Nancy Camel of Washington County and state of Maryland being in perfect health of body and of sound disposing mind memory and understanding considering the certainty of death and the uncertainty of the time thereof and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs and thereby be the better prepared to leave this world when it shall please God to call me hence do therefore make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say, First and principally I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God and my body to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my executor hereinafter named and after my debts and funeral charges are paid I devise and bequeath as follows I give and bequeath to the Manor Church of the Tunker denomination to which I belong situated in Washington County Maryland the sum of fifty dollars, To the Methodist Episcopal Church situated in the town of Sharpsburg Washington County Maryland and commonly known as Tolson Chapel the sum of twenty dollars and the receipt of the officers of the above named churches shall be a sufficient release or acquittance to my executor for the payment of the aforesaid money.

I give and bequeath unto Daniel Miller

Miller my chest my trunk and my stand, unto Hamilton
Miller son of Andrew Miller the sum of twenty five dollars, unto
Susan Miller daughter of Andrew Miller the sum of twenty five dollars
unto Thomas Miller son of Andrew Miller the sum of twenty five
dollars, unto Jonathan Miller son of Peter Miller the sum of twenty
five dollars & unto Susan Rebecca Roulette daughter of William
Roulette the sum of one hundred dollars together with my bed and
bedding, wearing apparel and other personal effects
not herein directly disposed of and the rest and residue of my estate

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint Benjamin
Franklin Roulette to be sole executor of this my last will and
testament revoking and annulling all former wills by me heretofore made
ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last will and testament
