Woman called Sophia age about thirteen years and a Slave for
use which said Slave Sophia to the said Ezekiel Thomson I will will
transact & own defend against me the Executors and administrators
and against every other person or persons whatsoever
in witness whereof I the said George Wallis as aforesaid have signed
at my hand and signed my seal this thirteenth day of June the
eighteen hundred and thirty seven (1837)
