

was accordingly enrolled as follows to wit: Whereas William Caultk of Talbot County in the State of Maryland has by Deed of Manumission bearing date the second day of July in the present year duly executed acknowledged and recorded according to law librated and set free among others the following negroes to wit: a negro man named Owen Roberts a negro woman named Caroline Roberts a negro girl named Ann Maria a negro woman named Elizabeth Murray a negro boy named Esau Murray a negro girl named Henry Murray and a negro boy named Charles Murray to take effect upon their arrival respectively to the ages of thirty and years, reserving to himself in the mean time the use and services of the said negroes; and has also in the said Deed fixed and determined the State and Condition of the issue which may be born of the female negroes in the said Deed mentioned on or before their arrival respectively to the ages of thirty and years as aforesaid. Now Know all men by these presents that the said William Caultk for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred dollars current money to him in hand paid by John H. Caultk who is now and for more than one year last passed has been a bona fide resident of the State of Maryland the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath bargain sold assign and transferred and by these presents doth bargain sell assign and transfer unto the said John H. Caultk his executors administrators and assigns all his the said William Caultk's right and interest in and to the said negroes for and during the period or term of servitude by him reserved as aforesaid that is to say from the date thereof until the said negroes shall respectively attain the ages of thirty and years; and also in and to the issue to be born of the female negroes above named during the period or term of their servitude as aforesaid for and during the periods or terms as fixed and determined by him as mentioned and stated in the said Deed of Manumission; To Have and To Hold all the right and interest of him the said William Caultk in and to the said negroes for and during the aforesaid terms of servitude so by him reserved and hereby bargain and sold to the said John H. Caultk his executors administrators and assigns together with all and every of the issue which the above named female negroes shall have on or before the
